## A LETTER FROM THE ELDERS

As most everyone is aware, the elders, deacons and ministers met recently to discuss areas of congregational work which could be implemented with a minimal burden, financial or otherwise. We wanted to develop programs that would have a potential of 100% participation. We decided on four initial programs that can have a strong impact on spiritual growth and congregational fellowship.

The first program beginning March 1st is a Prayer Ministry. We will print prayer request cards to be placed in the pews and handed to visitors. The ministry group will meet from 5:15-5:45 each Sunday to pray for specific needs. No long term commitment of participation is required, but everyone is welcome.

The second program is a Friends and Family day to begin March 31st. We will have them on the fifth Sunday months. All the classes will have a common theme and everyone is encouraged to invite their friends. After services, we will have lunch together. Following the meal, we will meet together for a singing service. This will replace the normal Sunday evening service.

The third program is Devotional and a Dinner. We will arrange groups to meet once a month at someone's home for a time of fellowship and study. The groups can select the time, place and menu that best fits their schedules. We will provide survey cards so members can identify what level of participation they would like. Can you host a group in your home? Can you lead a devotional? Are you willing to attend? We will work with the members to choose the group that best fits their schedules and needs.

We will also be starting a Greeter Ministry to begin February 15th. Teams of greeters will be stationed to meet visitors and members each Sunday morning. They will help the visitors by escorting children to their classes and informing the adults of the subject of the adult level classes. They will also encourage them to complete a visitor card. The teams will also greet prior to the worship services. Please be aware that you may be called on to help. We are a friendly congregation and this will further enhance that image.

Finally, we will be planning a Marriage Enrichment Seminar.

We hope that you will become involved in all these programs. They will enhance the relationships we have with each other and with those seeing us for the first time.
