World Bible School – First of all, a big thanks to Minnie Harris and Jeanette Hays for the countless hours of work they give each month in coordinating this program. I would also like to thank the dedicated team of WBS teachers who are involved with the mailing and the grading of lessons. Presently we are sending Bible lessons to 10 countries in Africa. Last year we sent out over 7,500 lessons, and this year alone we have mailed out 1,463 lessons already in the first six weeks of 2011. In sharing I would like to give you an idea of the scope of this work from just one country we send lessons to. Presently there are over 62,000 WBS students in Kenya alone. In 2010 there were 11 churches started there with 1,104 baptisms. At least 2 of those baptisms are a direct result of lessons mailed from Pearland. This work is providing wonderful results as you can see; however, we could do more. This work requires time and effort, and presently our team of workers consists of about 15 people. We could use more teachers, and we would invite and welcome more of our members to become a part of WBS.

Dominica – The Pearland Church extended an invitation to Brother Lewis Romain for us to become his sponsoring congregation in the States, and he graciously accepted our offer. I am thrilled that we are now able to send a regular monthly support to Lewis. We sent our first \$600 installment in January from the pledges that were given in support of this good work.

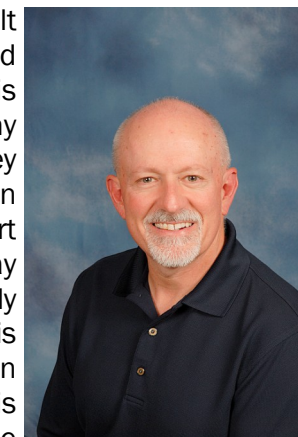

1 is off to a great start! I just wanted to share with you an update on some things that are going on with certain areas of our Mission

Lewis expressed his heartfelt gratitude for your love and generosity. He said that this was an answer to many prayers. The Hidden Valley Church of Christ in Houston has invited Lewis to be a part of their annual Missions Day in May. We are presently working on a time that Lewis can be with us while he is in the area. Chris Lindelof is also working to set up a time when we can meet with Lewis and some leaders from interested congregations to have a planning session on how we can better support the work in Dominica and set some long-term goals, especially in the area of how we may be able to help get a church building built in Portsmouth. In Brother Romain's January report he stated that they had recently had a campaign there in Portsmouth with some promising results and their church attendance for 2011 was averaging 45 for Sunday worship. Lewis continues to do his radio program each week and is constantly out in the community making visits and encouraging people. Please continue to pray for Brother Romain and his family as they labor for the Lord.



Benin – Mitzi and I will be making our first trip to Benin this summer with Brother Ed Jones and a team of 10 others. The plane tickets have been purchased and the itinerary is set. The Lord willing we will be departing Nashville on July 1st and are scheduled to be in Africa from July 2nd through the 12th with a return to the States on July 13th. We are excited about this opportunity and being able to see firsthand the work that is going on there. Please pray for the safety and the success of this team and also for the continued success of the preacher training school and those working so faithfully out in the field to spread the gospel. 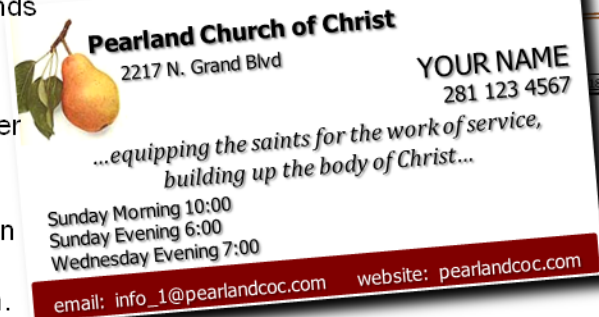

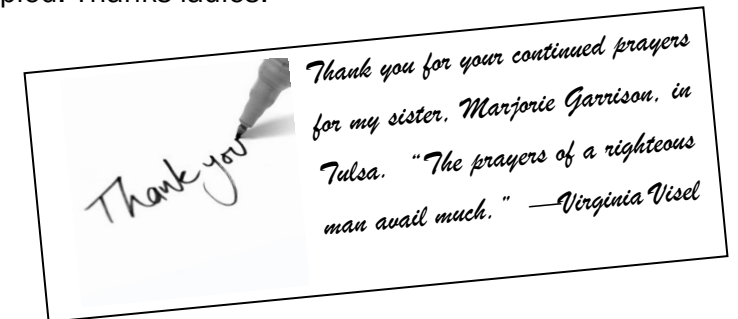


Baby Shower for Susan Peters on Sunday, February 27, from 4 to 6 PM in Annex. Susan is registered at Babies "R" Us and Target.
