protect their children from “creationism.” In the video, Nye says, “I say to the grownups, ‘If you want to deny evolution and live in your world that’s completely inconsistent with everything we’ve observed in the universe that’s fine, but don’t make your kids do it.’”

It can be frustrating to see how much free press and free air time is given to those who promote evolution as fact and insist it be taught as fact in our schools. You might even wish that there was a resource that you could go to that could refute the claims of the evolutionists in simple to understand terms. There is!

Dr. Brad Harub of Focus Press has just released a video for You Tube that is a direct refutation of the arguments made by Bill Nye. The video, which is just under fourteen minutes in length, does a good job of refuting the premise that EVERYONE in the world, except for a few creationists in the USA, knows that evolution is fact. Harub shows with quotes the thinking of the fathers of many fields of modern science. He also shows the inconsistencies of Nye’s arguments, as well as the unreliability and inaccuracies of some of the dating procedures that Nye bases his “facts” on.

The church was established there in December of 2011 and now has two young preachers working

there. They have had success in getting a small congregation started, but they were meeting in an extremely small room that is less than 10’ X 10’. The tract of land you purchased for them, located just south of the city proper, is an ideal location where new development is already underway.



Also announced last Sunday was the great news that students from BTC, who are on summer break, traveled to Sinarou, a fairly large village west of Parakou, where they held a week-long evangelistic effort. George Akpabli reported that as of last Wednesday there had been ten baptisms and more were expected. Let’s keep this good work in our prayers as God continues to open doors in that country. We are so blessed and honored to be a part of God’s effort in Benin. The reports that continue to pour in show us that this is truly a place where hearts are receptive.

Debbie and I will leave on Thursday of next week for the annual board meeting of FACE (French African Christian Education) in Benton KY. I have meetings to attend on both Friday and Saturday of that week. We plan to worship with the brethren at Benton on Sunday before we start making our way home. I hope to be able to share more encouraging news with you about the work in Benin when I return. I also will make inquiries into the Frankie Smith Ag Project, which is rapidly becoming a viable training tool that FACE is excited about and that BTC hopes to use as a tool to both educate and evangelize as well as to prepare graduates to supplement their income once they are in the field.
