member it being used almost exclusively as a song in preparation for observing the Lord's Supper. The title varies by hymn book: "Because He Loved Me So," "Why Did My Savior Come To Earth?" or "He Loved Me So."

The opening lines in its first two stanzas ask and answer two great questions. *1st stanza:* "Why did my Savior come to earth and to the humble go? Why did He choose a lowly birth? Because He loved me so!" *2nd stanza:* "Why did He drink the bitter cup Of sorrow, pain, and woe? Why on the cross be lifted up? Because He loved me so!" The love of the Savior and the love of God are declared and demonstrated throughout Scripture.

The message I shared with those who attended our most recent family encampment was all about God's everlasting love – as is stated in the book of Jeremiah. "I have loved you with an everlasting love" (Jer. 31:3).

In that message, I shared just three of the many reasons why God loves us with an everlasting love. He loves us because...

1. He is our Father in heaven. More than any other Gospel account, Matthew attributes the Lord with that expression. In fact, of the 15 times it is recorded in the first gospel, never is it uttered by anyone but the Lord. More than a third of its occurrences in the book of Matthew are taken from one sermon (Mt. 5:16,45; 6:1,9; 7:11,21). Had Jewish society focused so much on their heritage with the patriarchs or their affiliation with a sect that they no longer saw God as father?

The psalmist wrote, "Just as a father has compassion on his children, So the Lord has compassion on those who fear Him. For He Himself

WHY HE LOVES US

One hundred twenty years ago, James Gerald Dailey penned the words and composed the music to a hymn that many of us grew up with. I personally re-

knows our frame; He is mindful that we are but dust...But the lovingkindness of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting on those who fear Him, And His righteousness to children's children" (Ps. 103:13,14,17).

A father's love is a unique love that is expressed by giving, sacrificing, patience, discipline, guidance and protection. The best earthly fathers can do no more than dimly reflect those eternal expressions from our Father in heaven. As Father, and in all the ways of a father, He loves us.

2. He created us in His image. The heavens declare the handiwork of God (Ps. 19:1) and every creature on earth is proof of His creative genius, but only man was created in His image (Gen. 1:26). Of no other earthly creature can it be said that God so loved it that He made it in His image and gave to it qualities unique to Himself and His attributes. Because this is true, it explains in part why God loves us with an everlasting love. By His design, we reflect His nature and His glory as we live for Him.

3. Because He knows our potential. When others see only flaws, as was true of Ananias towards Saul (Acts 22:13-16) or as was true of Goliath towards David (1 Sam. 17:41-44), God saw chosen instruments to carry out works that brought deliverance and salvation. Nathaniel saw no potential in anyone from Nazareth (Jn. 1:46) and in Micah's day none could see the potential of anyone from Bethlehem (Mic. 5:2). But God did!

When the world chooses teams for its purposes, you and I may always be "the last one picked," but God sees in us a chosen vessel to accomplish His works (Eph. 2:10). Thus, He loves us when no one else does.

For these reasons, and many more, God loves us!
