One of my favorite British sitcoms (still in syndication) is **Keeping Up Appearances**, which was about a woman of low means who wanted to be a social climber and went to extraordinary lengths to give others the false impression that she was more affluent and socially sophisticated than she really was. It was British satire at its finest! To give an appearance to others that is false is hypocritical, and it is sin. However, appearances are important, and God has given very practical instructions on the subject.

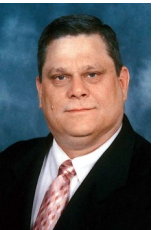
1 Peter 2:11,12 ¹¹ **Beloved, I urge you as aliens and strangers to abstain from fleshly lusts which wage war against the soul.** ¹² **Keep your behavior excellent among the Gentiles, so that in the thing in which they slander you as evildoers, they may because of your good deeds, as they observe them, glorify God in the day of visitation.**

NOTICE THE MOTIVATION FOR THE COMMANDS GIVEN: a Christian is an alien and a stranger. No doubt some of Peter's original readers had probably been born in the very place they were living at the time he wrote. In that sense, they could never be thought of as aliens and strangers, but rather as citizens entitled to all respect and glory derived from that citizenship. But as those purchased by the blood of Christ (1:19) and born again (1:3) with an inheritance in an eternal country not of this world (1:4; cf. Philip. 3:20), they now reside as aliens and strangers though they may well live in the very city of their birth.

NOTICE THE COMMANDS GIVEN: "...abstain from fleshly lusts...keep your behavior excellent..." Fleshly lusts are those desires of the flesh which are evil and dishonor the Father and the Son. Consider the young man who grew up in an environment where certain "colorful" acts were tolerated and considered acceptable. His carousing and his speech simply reflected his upbringing. Then he enlists in the military

and is being trained and under consideration for becoming an officer. Suddenly, he learns that what was formerly acceptable conduct is now "conduct unbecoming," and he must abstain or forfeit the right to become an officer. He would be taught that he cannot do that which disrespects the uniform. He would also be taught the proper conduct which is essential to the uniform. He now belongs to the military, and its code of morality and conduct is what matters. So it is with a Christian! We want to gauge our actions and our behavior by the standards of the world in which we live. But we've missed the point! We belong to God, and our citizenship is not of the world. Ask yourself this question: when a brother or sister finds offense in something that you do – do you say, "I don't see anything wrong with it; everyone does it and they don't make any negative judgments!"? Have you allowed the world or God to determine "conduct unbecoming"?



NOTICE THE CONSEQUENCES OF PROPER BEHAVIOR: Your friends in the world may very well slander you! By definition slander is unjustified (if you are guilty, it isn't slander), and it's also hurtful. The faith and conduct of a Christian will be misunderstood (often intentionally) and, because of your holy behavior (1:15), you will be falsely accused by those who hate God and His laws.

But there will also be those whose morality has not become bankrupt, and they will see in your lifestyle things to be admired though they may not emulate them – YET. Peter encourages us to act as God would have us act, knowing that someday those same people may be open to the gospel and will recall how you, as a Christian, endured shame and suffering without retreat. From that, they may well give glory to God and obey His gospel call.

KEEPING UP APPEARANCES, without hypocrisy, is essential to our souls and to the souls of those not yet obedient. Behavior and appearances matter!
