The 11th chapter of Acts contains a portrait of a dynamic congregation. Every element of its success can be duplicated today. Let's notice some of those things.

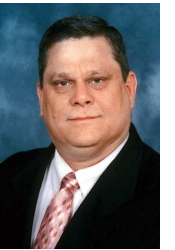
1. They were born of the word. Acts 11:19-21 ¹⁹So then those who were scattered because of the persecution that occurred in connection with Stephen made their way to Phoenicia and Cyprus and Antioch, speaking the word to no one except to Jews alone. ²⁰But there were some of them, men of Cyprus and Cyrene, who came to Antioch and began speaking to the Greeks also, preaching the Lord Jesus. ²¹And the hand of the Lord was with them, and a large number who believed turned to the Lord.

Even though our culture is very much a results-oriented culture, Satan has done a masterful job of selling the lie that the word of the Gospel just isn't enough. We're told that we need programs, we need a beautiful building, we need a social cause, etc. But the power of salvation is still in the Gospel (Rm. 1:16) and it is the word of God which is imperishable and incorruptible seed by which we are born again (1 Pt. 1:23-25).

2. They received encouragement in their faith. Acts 11:22-24 ²²The news about them reached the ears of the church at Jerusalem, and they sent Barnabas off to Antioch. ²³Then when he arrived and witnessed the grace of God, he rejoiced and began to encourage them all with resolute heart to remain true to the Lord; ²⁴for he was a good man, and full of the Holy Spirit and of faith. And considerable numbers were brought to the Lord.

We need more men like Barnabas. We know him as an encourager, and he was. But do we understand

the form that his encouragement took or the purpose for which he gave it? We read in the text that he encouraged "them all with a resolute heart." The Greek word for resolute really means "with purpose." To encourage without purpose is really nothing more than being politely complimentary. Barnabas was hardly sent there for that reason. He came to Antioch to make them stronger and more committed to the Lord and his words and actions were guided by that purpose. Our intent ought to be the same, "and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds" (Heb. 10:24).



With the power of the word and with the encouragement of a Barnabas to keep them true to the word, the result was a foregone conclusion. Antioch became the mission church of the Gentile world!

A congregation's spiritual vitality will be reflected in its love for the truth and its love for missions. The Antioch church not only committed men and resources to take the Gospel to the Gentile world, they rejoiced in hearing of its continuous power. Three times they sent Paul abroad, and always the word of the Gospel opened doors and saved souls. How they must have thrilled when reports came back!

You also believe in the power of the Gospel to change the hearts of sinners, and you also rejoice to hear of the effectual nature of evangelizing in mission fields. I look forward with anticipation to my fourth trip to Benin and visiting the congregations you have had a major role in establishing. Please be in prayer for this trip, and pray for my ability to have a resolute heart in encouraging them to be true to the word.
