This is a letter dated December 2, 2014, from Dave Chamberlin of Bear Valley:

Dear brethren,

The work at Bear Valley continues to keep everyone busy both in the classroom and out. This time of the year, with both Thanksgiving and Christmas so close together, our schedule has so many events taking place—seemingly all at once. I'm sure that you-all are feeling some of the same hustle and bustle.

This is my third year serving as one of the Bear Valley elders, and it has been one that has brought many challenges. We have had to go through an asbestos migration program in order to lay in new carpet. That particular process brought about some scheduling and relocation problems for the congregation, but I'm pleased to note that all of that is now behind us. Our attendance wavered at the time of construction but has returned to its former figures. We have also had to replace our baptistery, but that is nearly complete. My last baptism (grandson last Friday) took place at the Columbine building south of us.

The extension program is continuing to grow in our overseas work with men being trained as gospel preachers within their own culture. A great deal of interest in this program has been generated within the last six months with a view to establishing 50 more schools within the near future. We already have 18 schools that are flourishing with one in the northern region of Ghana, West Africa, that is predominately Muslim.

Barbara Ann and I want to thank all of you for your very generous support that has always been available for our living expenses. Some of you have been supporting us for a number of years, and as a result we commend you for your faith and patience. We really strive to do the Lord's will as we (you included) reach out to a lost and dying world in a very effective manner.

I just finished a Sunday morning class with the congregation dealing with cultural differences between ourselves and the people of both the Old and New Testament. Too many times we think of Bible folks being just like us but speaking a different language. We can better understand them if we know those cultural differences.

Again, thank you so much for your much needed help.
