The group of young men and women whom I meet with and lead in study each Tuesday night has often demonstrated a desire to better understand the reasons for the faith of a Christian.

This is key to the spiritual development of anyone! But it isn't a new challenge. The writer of the Hebrew epistle devoted 13 chapters to that very thing. As one reads the epistle, it becomes quite obvious that the urgent plea could be expressed in words like: *"All right, brothers and sisters, you have come to the Father through Jesus; and you have made your confession of faith in Jesus as the Christ of God. Others have ridiculed and denied and challenged every belief you have, but the truth is still the truth! Here are the things you need to remember and then increase your faith and your zeal from these facts."*

In this 2,015th year since the coming of the incarnate Word, the need to renew our faith and zeal based on our strong convictions of the assurances of our hope (Heb. 11:1) is every bit as vital as it ever was! Paul said to Timothy, **"I know whom I have believed and I am persuaded ..."** (2 Tim. 1:12).

While it isn't a new phenomenon at all, it is true that there is often a "disconnect" with some who are believers such that their belief hasn't really convicted them to a level of commitment beyond setting aside an hour a week for worship. Yet it seems that some of those to whom the Hebrew epistle was written had already exceeded that level and far beyond BEFORE their commitment began to weaken. The point at which they had begun to drift away (Heb. 2:1) appears to have been from a position of commitment that had already led them to endure a great conflict of sufferings which included public ridicule, embarrassment, reproaches, and significant financial

losses and even imprisonment for their faith (Heb. 10:32-34).

If you are one of those who feel that your faith has long since plateaued, the question worth considering is this: What's missing?



An elder once shared with me his deep concern for his grown children's apathy. They still attended regularly, and from a distance perhaps all seemed well. But he knew something was missing in regard to their faith. There were just too many "things that got in the way," and it happened too often.

His summation was that he and his wife had grown in their commitment to the point that they had as individuals and, as a couple, had their own convictions. They weren't functioning on the family perspectives about Christianity based on examples handed down from their parents. Like Paul they could each say, **"I (emphasis on the personal pronoun) KNOW (emphasis on unquestioned certainty) WHOM I (emphasis on the personal pronoun) HAVE BELIEVED (emphasis on unquestioned conviction) and I (emphasis on the personal pronoun) AM PERSUADED (emphasis on unquenchable fire that motivates).** This elder's lament was that he saw no evidence that the same had happened for his adult children.

My weekly meeting with the young adults who choose to come to our house each Tuesday is so rewarding because I see in them the growing faith that leads to a lifelong commitment to working and serving in the kingdom. What's special about them? NOTHING. What's special about the class? NOTHING. What's making the difference? They simply want to STUDY!
