The lectureship opened with the United States National Anthem and the US Virgin Islands March; the theme was from Haggai—"Consider your ways."

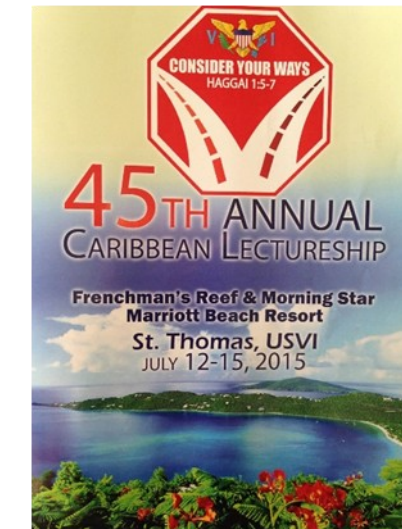
There were four inspiring messages on Sunday, three on Monday and Tuesday, and two on Wednesday.
