It's good to be back home! Most of you are aware that I was in Arkansas chairing a very productive meeting of the executive committee for F.A.C.E. We set in motion plans we believe will further advance the cause of Christ in French West Africa and paved the way for two upcoming events in September. We set the agenda for our fall annual board meeting in Benton, KY, and we've planned a great time of celebration. In September we will celebrate the 20th anniversary of the Benin Bible Training Center, or BTC.

In its 20 years of operation, BTC has graduated well over 150 men. Of those graduates, 151 are active preachers today! More than 7,000 converts have been won and more than 300 congregations established. BTC has reached every French-speaking country in French West Africa and continues to reach the lost.

Our celebration in September will honor the founders of this great work. We want to pay tribute to George Akpabli for his faith, his vision, and his tireless commitment to the work. We also want to honor two former elders of the Benton Church of Christ: Bill Morgan and Ed Jones. These two men went to Benin and met with their new missionary to ask him what his dream was. He said he wanted to train preachers. Today, we share in the Lord's harvest because of the faith, the commitment, and the dedication of these three men. Our celebration will be held in the beautiful facilities at Kentucky Dam Village. This site is an architectural marvel located on the Land Between The Lakes. It is part of a breathtaking panoramic view. There are numerous rooms as well as comfortably furnished cabins with every amenity (Deb and I have stayed there and know firsthand what a great facility they have).

On Friday night, we will have a fundraising banquet and a time of celebration. While many individuals and congregations are part of the successes of BTC, no congregation in the US is involved in the way and to the degree that Pearland is. Therefore, I want to personally invite you to attend the banquet! Pearland's footprint in Benin is massive, and the Frankie Smith Ag Project on the campus at BTC continues to train preachers to be self-supporting. The board would encourage you to take a few days, escape the heat, and enjoy some of the most beautiful country you've ever seen and help us celebrate the Lord's work! Tickets for the banquet are \$40 each. If you can't come (and that would be unfortunate), would you consider purchasing some tickets anyway? We have big plans for the future, and we want you to be a part of them!
