As board chairman for FACE, I had the sad duty of sending out a letter to all board members this week informing them of a substantial loss in our monthly support. Fortunately, I was also able to soften the blow with the news that we have gained additional supporting partners, though not enough to offset the recent loss. This financial loss did not come about because of anything we've done. We didn't lose it due to philosophical or doctrinal differences. We lost it because the congregation that gave it is suffering from declining membership. Their heart for missions is still there, but their loss in members has forced them to make severe cuts in their budget.

Membership in the Lord's kingdom is more than an RSVP for an eternal home in heaven. Though I fear that some only see it from that perspective (and they may well be bitterly disappointed in the end), the fact is that membership in the Lord's kingdom is a commitment to working in the Lord's vineyard. Jesus taught a parable based on exactly that premise (Mt. 20:1-16). And I wonder if ...

I wonder if parents have failed to teach the necessity of attendance and of commitment to the Lord's work.

I wonder if parents, preachers, and elders have failed to teach the purpose of attendance and commitment.

I wonder if church leaders have lost sight of the shepherd's role and thus no longer seek out the members who no longer attend. And if they don't attend, they certainly won't commit to the work.

I wonder if the congregation (from pulpit to pew) has lost enthusiasm for worship, for learning, and for stretching. If so, it would be impractical to assume new members will be any different.

I wonder if the craze for being entertained has brought many to ask one subjective question (upon which their every decision is weighed): "What's in it

for me?" Put another way, "I quit attending because it was a waste of time. I just didn't get anything out of it."

I wonder if the concept of growth produced by growth is lost on our present generation.

I wonder if the hunger for the Scriptures is gone. I get encouragement every week from a segment of the congregation. They express thanks for the message and for the way it touched them. Another segment never does. I see in them body language that says everything that shouldn't be said.

I wonder if the church as I knew it growing up will exist when my grandchildren are grown. I know the Lord's church will not pass from this world for He has promised as much. But will it still be in the part of the world that I share?

I wonder if our conscious decision to stop doing things that once increased membership and fueled the commitment to work has really improved our situation. Do congregations who remain mission-minded and who exert effort and finances to feed the flock and reach the community suffer from declining membership and declining interest? They seem to thrive and to grow. Why is that?

I wonder if the expectation of growth now resides only in those who preach and if responsibility to achieve growth is limited to those who preach.

Writing about such things, the Hebrews writer said, "But, beloved, we are convinced of better things concerning you, and things that accompany salvation, though we are speaking in this way. For God is not unjust so as to forget your work and the love which you have shown toward His name, in having ministered and in still ministering to the saints. And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence so as to realize the full assurance of hope until the end" (Heb. 6:9-11).
