Shortly after his graduation from West Point Military Academy in 1909, 2<sup>nd</sup> Lt. George Patton wrote a letter to his parents in which he stated, “I wake up at night in a cold sweat imagining that I have lived and done nothing.”

“Go out and make a difference in the world,” “Leave your mark,” “It only takes one to change the world”—these statements and dozens more like them are often heard in the early days of June. Such statements are the stock-in-trade of commencement speeches. Yet, they aren’t meant to be clichés; they are intended to challenge and to be that spark that inspires someone to greatness.

It is no accident nor is it coincidental that these inspiring remarks are the themes of graduation speeches. Graduation is an acknowledgment that a certain level of understanding and proficiency has been acquired. The tools needed to be successful have been learned. Having been equipped with those tools, the graduate begins, with purpose, the journey of life as an adult.

We also have been equipped for every good work (2 Tim. 3:16-17). Specifically, we’ve been equipped for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ (Eph. 4:12). We’ve been given everything pertaining to life and godliness (2 Pt. 1:3). And we know that to whom much has been given, much will be required (Lk. 12:48). All that is lacking is that same desire and that same awareness of how precious life is that led a young man, destined for greatness, to write, “I wake up at night in a cold sweat imagining that I have lived and done nothing.”
