NEW CLASS, READING, KEY WORD RALPH BRYANT

The elders have decided to make a change to our Sunday morning Bible classes for the adults. They are going to consolidate the adult classes to one class that will meet in the auditorium. The plan is to continue for six months, two quarters. They've asked me to lead the class for the next few weeks, until Brother Justin gets here. The topic of we are going to address is, "Christ and Him Crucified."

After Brother Chris made the announcement about the coming change, he suggested everyone read what they thought appropriate for that topic. I really like the idea of folks reading ahead of time, so that when they get to class we will already have some common thoughts. I announced that I would include suggested reading to prepare us for this week's discussion. The passage that I want you to read and give some thought to is 1 Corinthians 1:18 – 2:2. (Here it is in the ESV for your convenience--

18 For the word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. 19 For it is written, "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and the discernment of the discerning I will thwart." 20 Where is the one who is wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the debater of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world? 21 For since, in the wisdom of God, the world did not know God through wisdom, it pleased God through the folly of what we preach to save those who believe. 22 Jews demand signs and Greeks seek wisdom, 23 but we preach Christ crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and folly to Gentiles, 24 but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God. 25 For the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men. 26 For consider your calling,

brothers: not many of you were wise according to worldly standards, not many were powerful, not many were of noble birth. 27 But God chose what is foolish in the world to shame the wise; God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong; 28 God chose what is low and despised in the world, even things that are not, to bring to nothing things that are, 29 so that no human being might boast in the presence of God. 30 And because of him you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness and sanctification and redemption, 31 so that, as it is written, "Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord." 1 And I, when I came to you, brothers, did not come proclaiming to you the testimony of God with lofty speech or wisdom. 2 For I decided to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ and him crucified.

One question I would like for each of you to ponder before you get to Bible class next Sunday morning is, **"What is included when one teaches nothing except Jesus Christ and him crucified?"**

Another thing that I announced on Sunday morning is that I was going to start choosing a keyword for each sermon, with the intent of asking folks, especially our young people, to keep a tally of how many times the keyword is used during the sermon. Last week I had three people announce to me how many times I said the word Christ, and I got three different totals: 19, 27, and 38 (I have no idea which is correct). This week I would like to use the word **"cross"** as our keyword. Parents, encourage your kids to bring a tally book or a notepad and to write down the word cross at the top. Then have them make a mark underneath the word cross each time they hear that word during the lesson. I would love to have them come by after the service and tell me how many marks they made during the sermon.
