Suddenly all of the pictures and accounts that we saw and heard in the media were about heroic rescue moments, and the mobilization of people all across the country to try to help those that were in need. It didn't matter what your social standing was, everyone was helping everyone. We banded together in ways we

wouldn't have dreamt of just a month ago. We were going about seeking ways to be of service, doing backbreaking and even heartbreaking work for and with people we never even knew existed until the disaster brought us together. It is so heartwarming to behold that I do not want to fail to give God the credit, and to realize that he can use the worst of things to bring about the best of things.

Right now, I am praying that Hurricane Irma be turned to the north and not be allowed to do major damage to anyone. I have friends and loved ones in the predicted path, and I don't want them to be stricken. But if the storm hits and they suffer a blow, I pray that Romans 8 will be played out in their lives, and that they will recognize God is working among them.
